CELEBRATION CHOIR

The *Celebration Choir* was formed in 1996. Led by the Holy Spirit, the Music Department heard the needs of the congregation at Dupont Park Seventh-day Adventist Church and orchestrated the organization of a gospel choir. Under the leadership of Pastor Jonathan A. Thompson, the music ministry of Celebration was nurtured and cultivated.

During these early years, Celebration re-established the presence of contemporary gospel music at Dupont Park Seventh-day Adventist Church and has been instrumental in ministering to the varied musical tastes of the church. In December 2000, Everard “*Rodi*” Mattox became the leader of the Celebration Choir. Under his leadership, Celebration has grown musically and continues to strive for the highest level of musical excellence.

Celebration participates in various church services as well as programs and engagements throughout the DC/Maryland/Virginia area. Their ministry has allowed them to minister with artists such as Vanessa L. Williams of the Richard Smallwood Singers, Stellar Award Nominee Minister Terrell Hunt, Stellar and Grammy Award Nominee VaShawn Mitchell and most recently Stella Award Nominee Kierra “KiKi” Sheard.

In November 2008 and 2010, Celebration traveled south to Orlando, Florida to minister at Patmos Chapel Worship Center. In October 2015, the choir had the privilege of ministering at the Meadowvale West Seventh-day Adventist Church in Toronto, Canada.
