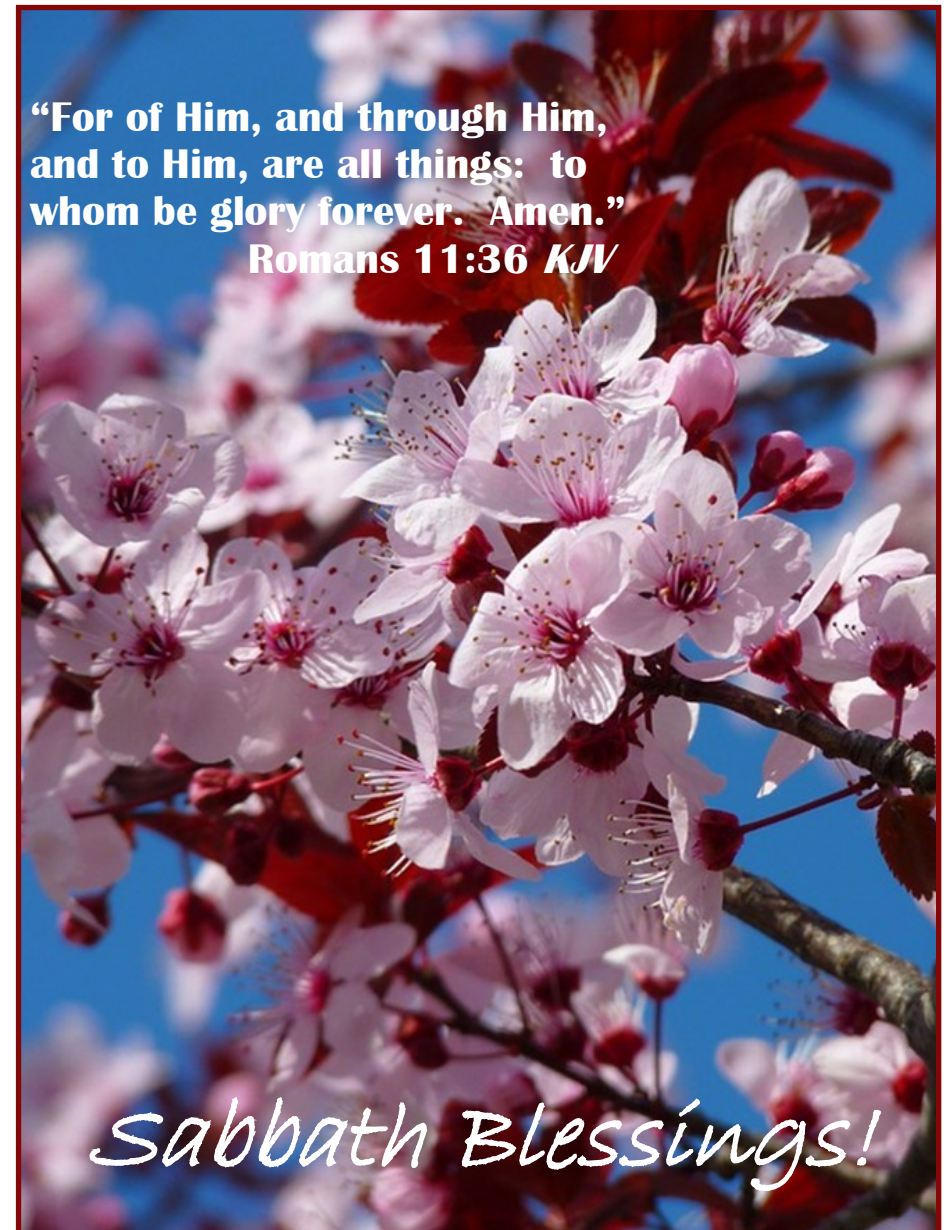
Church Mission Statement
