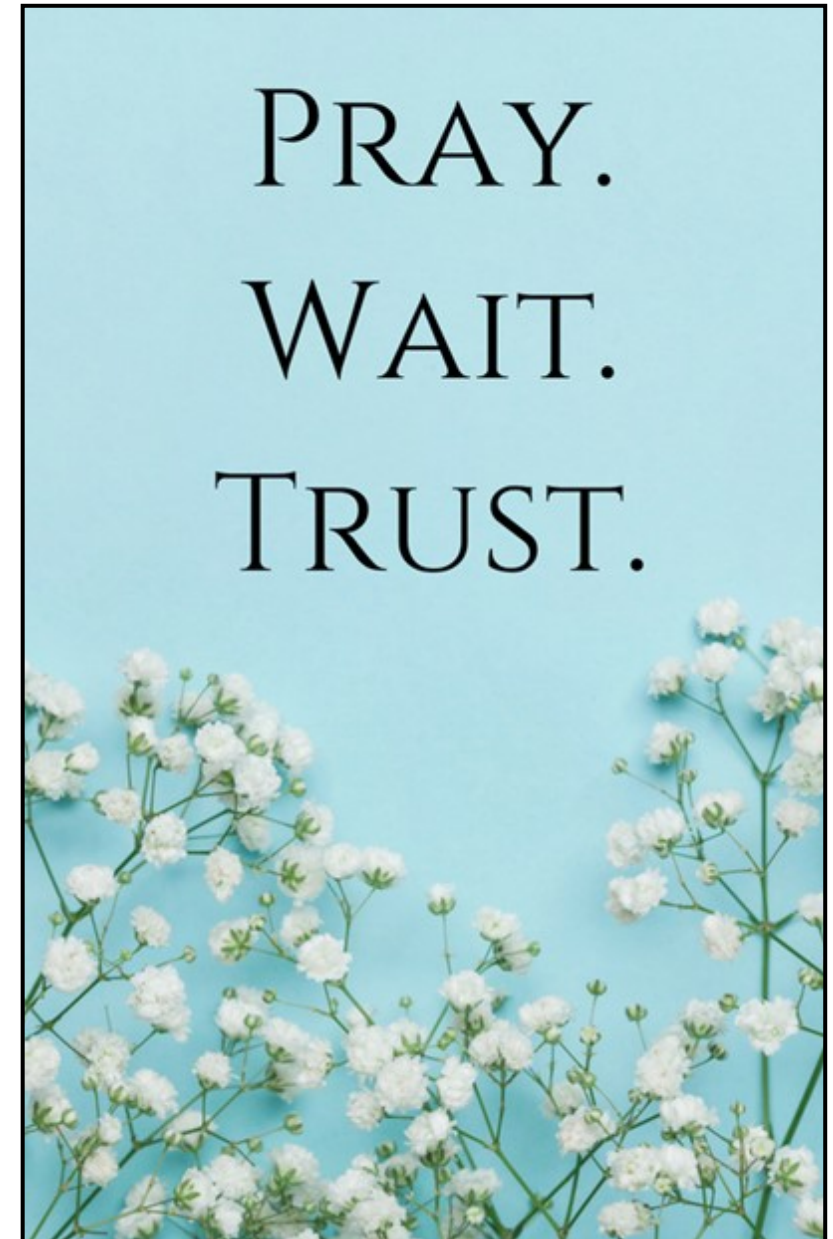

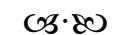
Church Mission Statement
