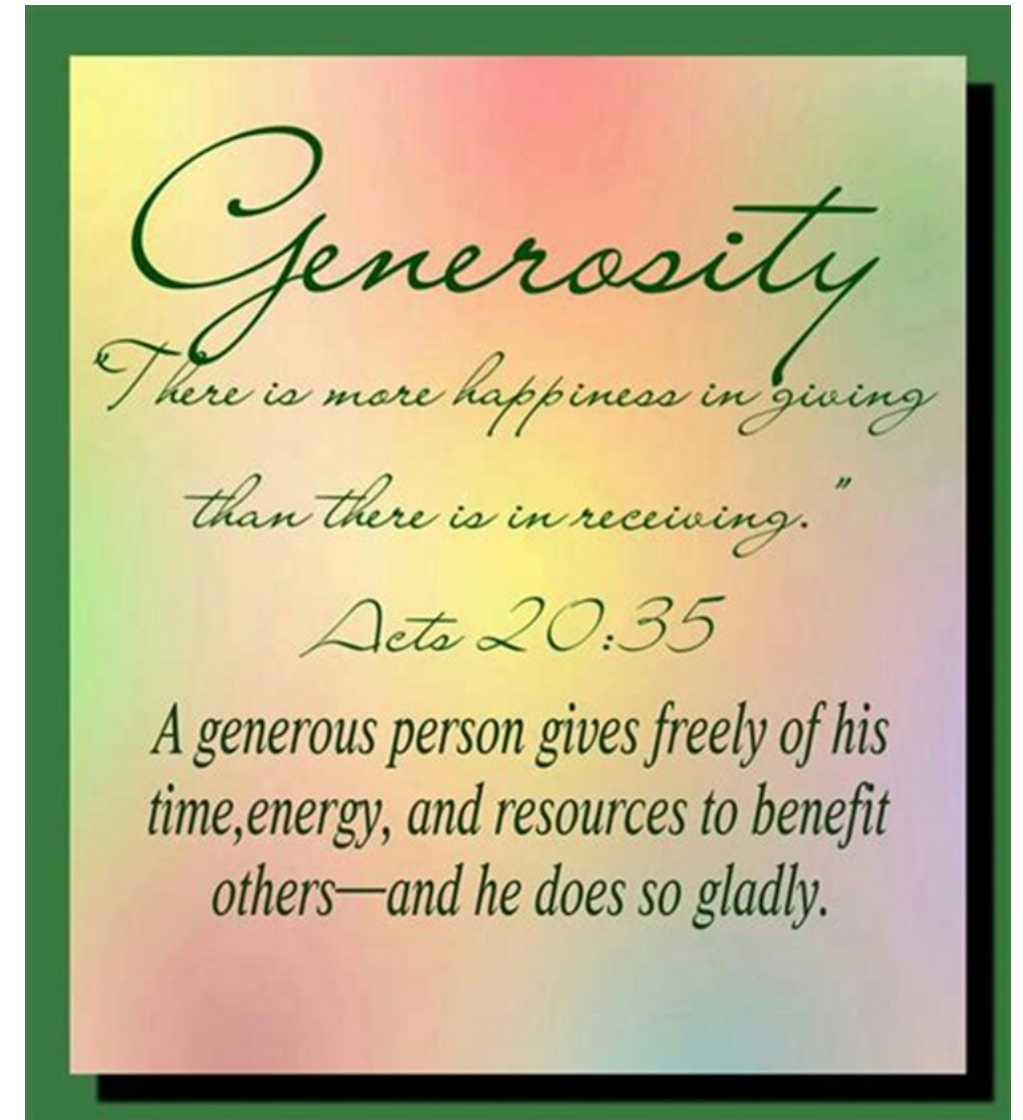

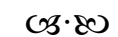
Church Mission Statement

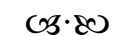
