Church Mission Statement

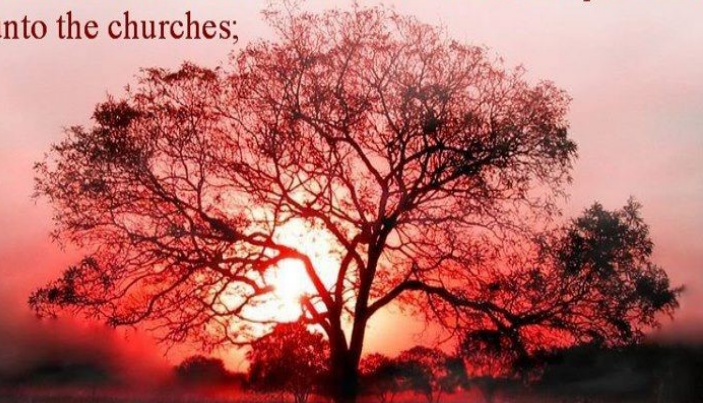

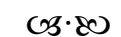
