Church Mission Statement

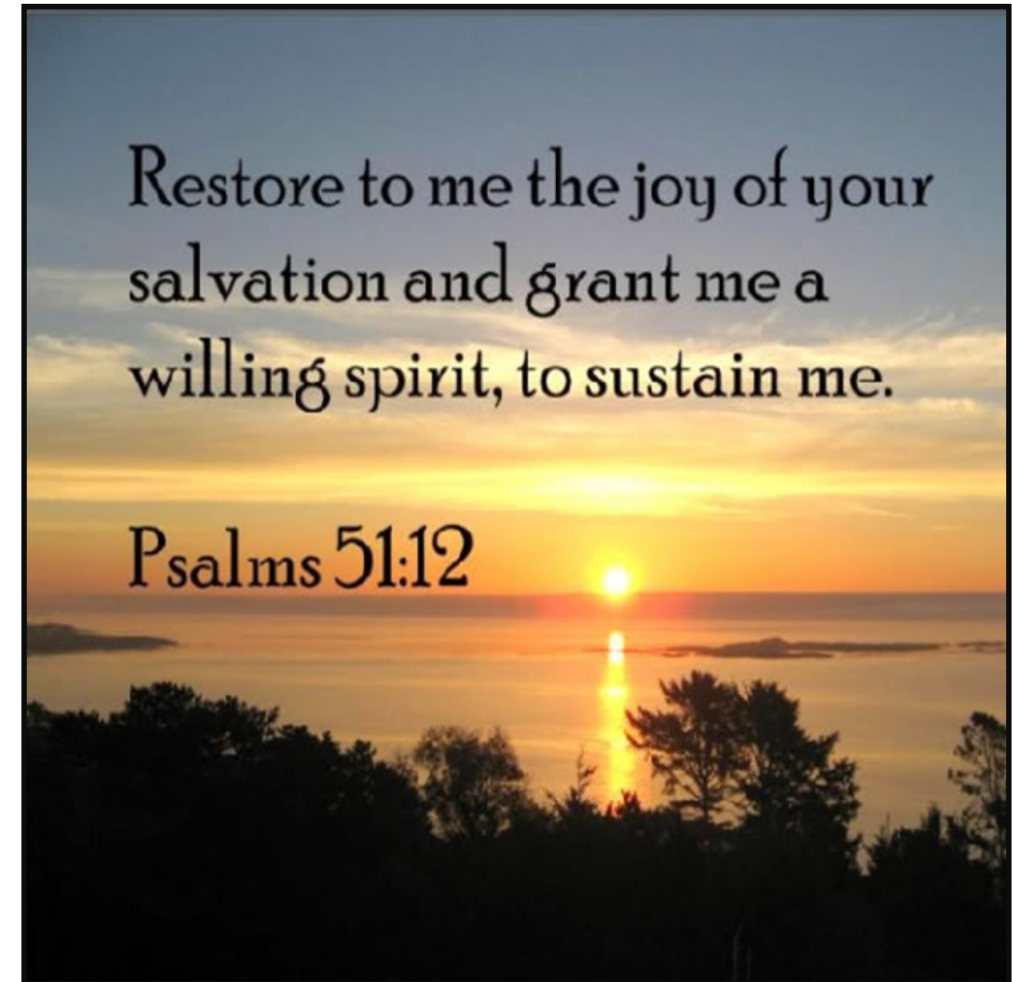

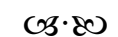

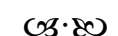

Health Nugget

Food should not be washed down; no drink is needed with meals. Eat slowly, and allow the saliva to mingle with the food.
